December 14, 2021

Chairman Terry Doyle called the meeting to order at 6:59 p.m.

OLD BUSINESS

There was no Old Business to discuss.

NEW BUSINESS

CT Water Company (owner), Jessica Demar (applicant) permit application

Jessica Demar, Regulatory & Compliance Coordinator for the CT Water Company, discussed the application to replace a washed-out pedestrian footbridge over the Menunketesuck River. The old bridge has been removed and a new location has been chosen for the bridge. The trail with the bridge begins near the Platt Nature Center on Roast Meat Hill Road and it ends near, but not up to, the reservoir. Ms. Demar said the new location appears to have had a bridge there in the past. No excavation is planned for the area. Concrete will be brought in and the engineered bridge will be built on site. Chairman Doyle said this site had been talked about previously and therefore can be voted on tonight. *G. Johnson moved, seconded by E. Pizzuto, to approve the footbridge construction. G. Johnson, E. Pizzuto, T. Doyle, and C. Plum voted in favor of the motion. New commission member D. Cutillo abstained. The motion carried.*

Donna Baiocchi & Anthony Savino (owners), Anthony Savino (applicant) permit application

Jason Nemergut, P.E., presented the plan for an in-ground swimming pool, pool house and fencing next to the wetland area at 197 Route 80. The area wetlands were flagged by Richard Snarski in 1991. The area proposed for the pool is all lawn now and was probably filled many years ago. There was a consensus of the members that the site does not need an inspection at this time. The plan is scheduled to be voted on at the January 11, 2022 Regular Meeting.
