143 Cow Hill Road - Timber Harvest including a small stream crossing**

Members discussed the proposed timber harvest on a 77 acre property on Cow Hill Road. The project will include a portable bridge and/or corduroy to cross an intermittent watercourse. The applicants are requesting a "Permitted Use as of Right" because "a selective timber harvest is considered to be "harvesting of crops" under the Killingworth Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Regulations, according to a memo from Daniel Thomas submitted with the application.

*C. Reimers moved, seconded by C. Plum, to approve the application as an "as-of-right" activity. The motion carried unanimously.*
