OLD BUSINESS

There was no Old Business to discuss at this meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

Arthur Siegel permit application - addition - 17 Kelsetown Road

John Marcum attended the meeting to present information on the proposal for an addition on the back of an existing house. Enforcement Officer Cathie Jefferson said the wetland area nearby is a grassy area that has already been filled. There was a consensus of the members that a site walk is not necessary. Discussion will continue at the October 12th regular meeting, and a vote on the application is expected at that time.

Tom O'Hare permit application - driveway crossing - 200 Little City Road

Engineer Jason Nemergut presented information on the T. O'Hare application for driveway construction to access a proposed single family home. This subdivision was approved in 1999 and the proposed 24" culvert is in the same location as was approved at that time. Mr. Nemergut explained that the culvert will have clean fill over it, no trap rock. There was a consensus that this application does not need a site walk. A vote is anticipated at the October meeting.

ENFORCEMENT OFFICER'S REPORT

- Enforcement Officer C. Jefferson said there are a lot of building permits being issued, but homeowners and contractors are having a difficult time getting building materials.
