1. The meeting was called to order at 11:00 a.m. Alternate Dennis Rich was seated.

2. Approval of minutes

5. Outreach projects: Preservation 101 presentation

Lucinda Hogarty reported back after attending a presentation in Clinton given by Preservation Connecticut, whose circuit riders are assigned to bring expertise to individual towns. Hogarty briefed the committee on the organization and the services they offer, citing recent success stories in Clinton> The circuit rider described various efforts by the town of Clinton including a 3D diorama of an historic district showing what Main Street would have looked like had the buildings been preserved.

The full PowerPoint, which will be shared on the town website, covered:

- History of Historic preservation, early efforts
- Preservation as sustainability, e.g. Green Bank efforts to promote energy efficiency of old houses
- Cataloging inventories of historic houses and structures
- Federal, State and Local historic districts
- Grants and Incentives

The presentation will be shared with the Killingworth Historical Society, and was followed by brief discussion.
